Stop-in at The Saturna General Store to see the regular rotating art showcase by Arts Saturna. Take a self-guided tour to find Dreamscapes Studio with textile art by Donna Fay Digance, see original paintings by Janet Strayer, Grouchy Crab

Pottery & Gifts with functional and whimsical ceramic wares by Tricia DeJoseph, Art Dream Gallery with prints and paintings by Jack Campbell, and acrylic and watercolour paintings by Anne Popperwell at her studio.

Pick up your vacation read at Boot Cove Books, handmade gifts at This n That Arts & Crafts Studio, and don't miss the Saturday Market for all of the island's favourites, including Urduina the goat.



NATURE

Watch the eagles soar above, the orcas swim past, and the sun sink out of the sky. Cycle across the island and sleep under the stars. Kayak under the ancient cliffs with the creatures of the Salish Sea. Hike along the highest point in the Southern Gulf Islands and see the world from a perspective you've never seen before. Here on Saturna, you'll often have it all to yourself.

GULF ISLANDS NATIONAL PARK RESERVE

Protecting half of the island's magnificent landscape, the Gulf Islands National Park Reserve is a lush paradise with rare ecosystems for you to explore. From leisurely strolls to adventurous hikes as well as stunning kayak and cycling routes, hit your stride on its many trails, beaches, and shorelines.

ACTIVITIES

WATCH FROM SHORE
Look for Orcas and other sea life at East Point, a stop on the Whale Trail and home to major marine research and education. Shore-based whale watching helps protect marine ecosystems.

MEET THE FERAL GOATS
Equal to the island's human population, you'll find the goats roaming Brown Ridge. Having long escaped captivity, they thrive in the Mediterranean-like climate without any natural predators.

BEACH HOP
From sandy beaches to sun-baked tidal reefs and secluded coves, you'll never be far from the shore. Watch for bioluminescence in warmer months and try a cold plunge in Cozy Season.

GO BIRDING
A birder's paradise with many species migrating here, bring your binoculars and try to spot hawks, finches, owls, gulls, thrushes, sparrows, ospreys, herons, bald eagles and more.

LEARN THE HERITAGE
Located in the Fog Alarm Building at East Point, the Saturna Heritage Centre is one of the most iconic buildings in the Southern Gulf Islands. Home to the island archives, natural history exhibits, heritage displays, a gift shop, and seasonal activities.

GET ON THE WATER
Whether on a tour as part of a course or on a self-guided adventure, kayaking is one of the best ways to experience Saturna's natural beauty. Make sure you reserve some time to see the island from the water.

VISIT CABBAGE ISLAND
A paddler's and boater's oasis, this uninhabited island in Tumbo Channel has mooring buoys, five campsites, incredible sandy beaches, and quiet trails.



CELEBRATIONS

Saturna hosts many fun community events throughout the year. Celebrate fall with Harvest Fest at Sage Hayward Vineyards featuring live music, family friendly games, and wine tastings.

The popular Pig Roasts, which happen every fall and

spring, support the Saturna Island Volunteer Firefighter Association.

Summer brings anticipated island-wide events. There are opportunities to meet and greet local artists at their studios at the annual Saturna Art Tour. The famous Canada Day

Lamb BBQ greets over a thousand guests annually for family fun activities and delicious local lamb—an island tradition since 1950.

Be part of the island family by attending one of these community celebrations.



FOOD

Find pub favourites and sweeping ocean views at the Lighthouse Pub, weekend evening specials at Saturna Cafe, and light lunches and snacks at the Vibrational Cafe. For modern classics with local ingredients, the Feral Goat Bistro at Sage Hayward

Vineyards is a must-stop. Be sure to visit the Saturna General Store for provisions, including fresh produce, local Campbell Farm meats, fresh baked bread and pastries, specialty deli items (great for picnics!) and a selection of beer and liquor.

Saturna Island, also known as **TEKTEKSEN**, meaning Long Nose in SENĆOTEN, is within the traditional territories of the Coast Salish people. Its name comes from the beautifully long, tapered shoreline at East Point, an important hunting and fishing location for the **WSÁNEĆ** peoples for thousands of years.

The name Saturna comes from the Spanish naval schooner Santa Saturnina which arrived at the island in 1791 when the Spanish were exploring the Pacific coastline. A remote paradise, Saturna Island showcases some of the most beautiful wilderness and rural landscapes among the Southern Gulf Islands. The space is quiet and the stars are bright.

Home to a small, close-knit community you're likely to encounter more wildlife here than people—and we like it that way. So explore the unexplored, do a lot or do nothing. For a moment, be part of this cozy island family.

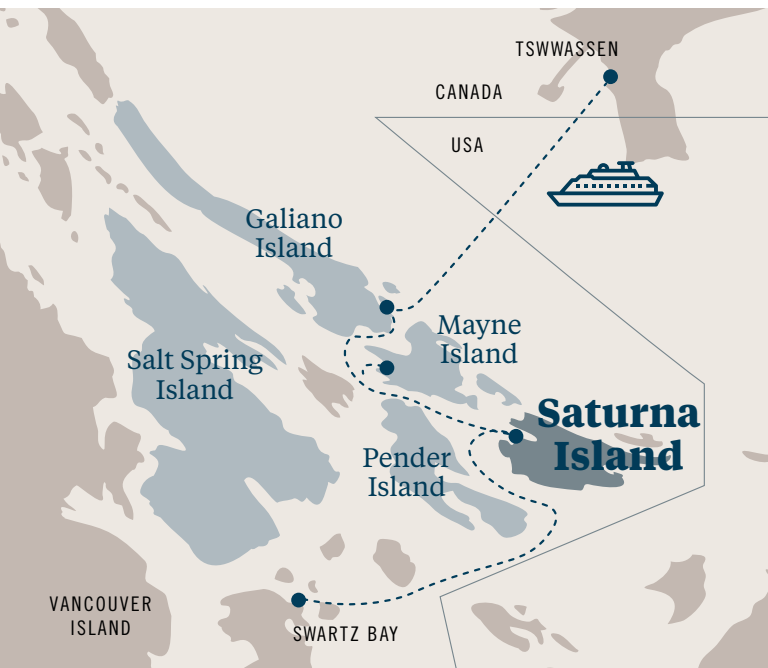
BE RESPECTFUL

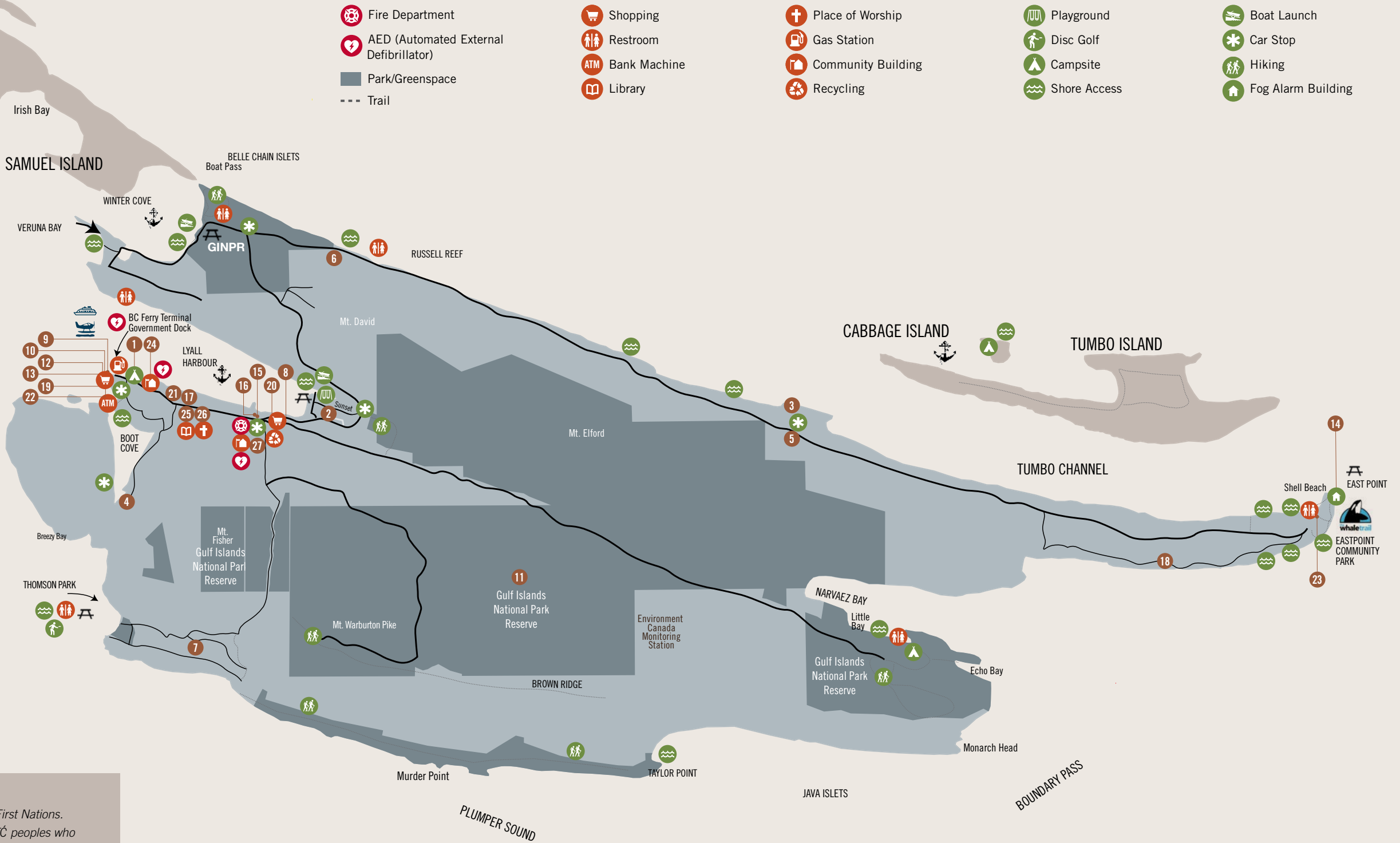
